It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such an accident.
3. The organisers reserve the right to decline to accept any entry and may cancel the entry of any competitor or exhibitor without stating any reason.
4. Competitors and their servants must carry out any directions given to them by authorised officials of the show and failure to do so may result in the competitor being excluded from taking any further part in the events and forfeiting all entry fees.
5. When not competing horses and vehicles shall be kept strictly to the nominated areas and no exercising or practicing shall be carried out except in the nominated areas.
6. Horse and ponies in the harness classes must be 4yrs old or over.
7. The decision of the Judges shall be final in all events.
8. Any dogs brought to the show must be kept on a lead.
9. All Cups and Trophies must be collected on the day and are to be returned to the Secretary at least **THREE WEEKS** before the Show in the following year or at such other time as the organisers may decide.
10. All horseboxes and other vehicles **MUST** be parked as directed by the stewards on the day and are parked on the showground entirely at their owner's risk.
